



A Halloween Craft

Materials Needed:

- One piece of cardstock, standard size (orange, black, green, or purple)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- String

Vocabulary:

- bat
- half-oval
- half-circle
- triangle
- body
- head
- ear
- wing

Instructions:

1. Cut out the bat stencil.
2. Take a piece of cardstock, fold it in half, hamburger-style.
3. Unfold the cardstock and cut on the line.
4. Fold each piece of cardstock in half again, hamburger-style.
5. Trace the bat stencil on each folded piece of cardstock. **MAKE SURE** that the center of the bat's body is lined up with the **FOLD** of the cardstock (i.e. **NOT** the open edges).
6. Cut out each bat and unfold them.
7. On one of the bats, cut a slit on the folded line from the **TOP** of the bat's head to the middle of its body. On the other bat, cut on the line from the **BOTTOM** of the bat's body to the middle of its body.
8. Put the two bats together by joining the slits.
9. From the paper scraps, cut four small rectangles and fold them in half.
10. Glue one half of a rectangle to the inside of one bat; glue the other half of the rectangle to the side of the bat next to it. Repeat on the inside of each bat.
11. Punch a hole in the top of the bat. Attach string and hang up the bat.
